

**Minutes of Called Meeting
Elbert County Board of Commissioners
Wednesday, August 17, 2022**

Chairman Lee Vaughn called the meeting to order, Present were Chairman Vaughn, Commissioner Casey Freeman, Commissioner Chris Alexander, Commissioner Freddie Jones, County Administrator Phil Pitts, County Attorney Bill Daughtry, CFO Macie Witcher, County Clerk Tamara Butler, media. Commissioner David Hunt was not able to attend.

After the Pledge to the United States flag the invocation was given by Mr. Daughtry.

Adoption of the Agenda. Commissioner Freeman made a motion to adopt the agenda.

Discussion and Approval to advertise the FY 2023 Budget. Chairman Vaughn stated after some discussion about the budget and not having time to look at it thoroughly, he recommends this be tabled until later when all information is gathered, discussed and agreed on. Commissioner Jones made the motion to table this item until further notice. Commissioner Alexander seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.

Discussion and Approval to put out bids for a 72" cut Zero-Turn mower for the Parks and Recreation Department. Tim Gaines stated they were in need of a mower for Recreation Department and gave some specs on the different mowers he was looking at. The funds will come from SPLOST. Commissioner Alexander made a motion to approve putting out bids for the mower. Commissioner Jones seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.
