
### General Fund Budget History

- FY 2021 Budget \$12,349,360
- FY 2022 Budget \$13,697,155
  - Increase of \$1,347,795 from FY 2021
  - Millage rate dropped 1.487 unincorporated and 1.107 incorporated
- FY 2023 Budget \$15,124,995
  - Increase of \$1,427,840 from FY 2022
  - Millage rate dropped .013 unincorporated and .165 incorporated


## General Fund Budget History

- FY 2024 Budget \$15,756,890
  - Increase of \$631,895 from FY 2023
  - Millage rate increased .228 mills
- FY 2025 Budget \$15,981,825
  - Increase of \$224,935 from FY 2024
  - Millage rate dropped .05 unincorporated and .253 incorporated

### Tax Anticipation Note

- 2020 Elbert County Borrowed \$1,600,000
- 2021 Elbert County Borrowed \$3,921,468.84
- 2022 Elbert County Borrowed \$2,000,000
- 2023 Elbert County Borrowed \$999,050.68
- 2024 Elbert County Borrowed \$1,296,585.29

### General Fund FY 2026 Budget

- Total FY 2026 Increase \$974,165
- Personnel Services \$894,295 increase (92%)
  - Salaries Health Insurance Workers Comp. Insurance PTSD Insurance
- General and Administrative \$79,870 increase (8%)
  - Training and Education for SO and Detention out housing for inmates –
    Software for cameras and new electronic devices for SO increase in software fees and technical services cost of utilities on site and off site medical costs for inmates Court interpreters Court reporters


#### General Fund FY 2026 Budget

- Public Safety as a Whole \$559,630 increase (57%)
  - Sheriff Department Detention Center Animal Control EMS EMA
    - Fire Department
- Sheriff Department Increase \$210,300
  - \$177,200 Personnel Cut \$18,400 part-time/postage/Body Cameras
- Detention Center Increase \$198,050
  - \$167,050 Personnel Cut \$88,000 Part-time/Equipment/Building/Meals
- EMS Increase \$86,300
  - \$111,000 Personnel Cut General & Admin \$24,700
- Animal Control Increase \$50,750
  - \$51,300 Personnel Cut \$9,100 Part-time/General &Admin
- Sheriff Total Increase \$459,100 (47.1% of Budget Increase)


- Rollback Unincorporated 9.696

  - Elbert County will be short \$473,581
- Current Unincorporated 9.928
- Current Incorporated 10.349
  - Elbert County will be short \$231,088
- Advertised Rate Unincorporated 10.183
- Advertised Rate Incorporated 10.604
  - Needed amount to meet budget

#### New Sales Tax for Elbert County

- FLOST Floating Local Option Sales Tax
- FLOST was approved November 4, 2025 ballot



#### What is FLOST

- A new countywide sales tax to be used exclusively to provide property tax relief.
- It will be levied for 5 years at 1%
- County and cities must levy a property tax to be eligible.
- Elbert County will receive 100% of the funds

#### What does FLOST mean for tax payers??

- One penny per dollar added to purchases in Elbert County
- Funds must be used exclusively for property tax relief
- Each property tax bill must state the amount property tax has been reduced
- Elbert County will start collecting in CY
  2026 and applied to 2027 property taxes



How much could this reduce my property taxes?

#### How much could this reduce my property taxes?

- Advertised Millage Rate is 10.183 (County Only)
  \$225,000 appraised value (\$916.47) No exemptions
- EXAMPLE: Elbert County collects \$3,000,000 in FLOST during calendar year 2026
- \$3,000,000 is approximately 3.26 mills
- County only property taxes for tax year 2027 would be \$623.07
- Savings of \$293.40 on County property tax or 47.09%
